Welcome to Prosperity Pardner

This brief guide will introduce you to our organisation and tell you more about what we do.

We've also included the very simple instructions that you will need to operate your account with us.

Who are we?

Prosperity Pardner was formed in July 2020.

Our origin was very simple, you could almost say we are a creation of nature's ever expanding and improving plan for humanity.

We are a small group of individuals who had all experienced the same thing. Low interest rates from all of our banks (who were making billions from our money), along with poor customer service and interaction from some of our banks.

We did not know each other shortly before Prosperity Pardner began, but we had been working together loosely for the promotion of a service we were all using.

As the quality of that service decreased, we realised that now would be an ideal time to provide a **quality** system to help people grow their money.

We had a discussion and got to know each other better and realised that our service would be a natural evolution of the traditional Pardner or Susu system that has been in use for generations in the Afro-Caribbean community.

What is a traditional Pardner or Susu

A Pardner, or Susu as it is commonly known in Western Africa, is a type of rotating savings and credit association. The traditional system is simple and depends on the members of the pardner knowing and trusting each other.

Each person puts in a fixed amount of money at regular intervals, this could be weekly or monthly.

Each week or month everyone takes a turn at receiving the money.

The system can be a savings method for those who take their lump sum at the end of the cycle or a loan for those who get their money upfront.

How are we different

Unlike traditional Pardners and Susus, we pay you a reward for using our service.

Also we are not able to do the traditional rotational weekly or monthly payout, where each person receives a turn or 'hand'.

Here's why. Traditional Pardners and Susus depend on long established circles of trust, such as family members or work colleagues. The reason for the deep trust element is that 1 person is responsible for holding or safeguarding the money until it is paid out to the group members.

This is in addition to the fact that some people will receive their payout before they have paid anything!

We obviously cannot do that. We want to make our service as widely available as possible, which means we will be dealing with hundreds of people who we don't know. It would be irresponsible of us to risk your money in that way.

How much is the reward

At the moment our minimum reward is 5% per quarter.
We will review that from time to time with a view to increasing it.
Our current reward % details are available on our website.

How can we afford to do this in these times of perceived economic uncertainty

We work with various highly skilled investment related organisations. These organisations are involved in areas such as:
The stock market, Cryptocurrencies and Forex (Foreign Exchange).

These industries always make money regardless of how the economy is doing, because they allow for money to be made in periods of affluence and austerity.

What do I need to do to join

Joining Prosperity Pardner is easy.

Visit <https://prosperitypardner.com> and you can complete the easy online application form there.

Once you've filled out all of the information and have completed the form, it will automatically be sent to us.

We will then send you information on how to make your monthly payments.

Once your first payment has been made and your account created (this can take up to 10 days), we will email the details to you.

Account operating instructions

When your application process has been completed, you will be sent a secure Internet link where you can view your online statement.

You will not be able to update the statement yourself, but it will show you the following information:

Name

Address

Email address

Date the account was opened

Account operating instructions (Continued)

There you will see a list of your payments and the date you should expect your payout.

Please note that payouts are only made *AT THE END OF THE PARDNER PLAN TERM*.

This means that your money will be returned to you at the end of your chosen Pardner Plan, depending on whether it is 3 months, 6 months or 12 months.

Early withdrawal of funds is not allowed under any circumstances.

You **MUST** wait until the Pardner Plan term and processing time has elapsed before you receive your payment.

It is your responsibility to ensure we have **CORRECT** up to date information:

Name

Phone number

Email address

Bank account number

Sort code

If any of this information is incorrect and you fail to give us the new details following a change, and money is paid to the old details, we cannot be held responsible.

Pardner Payout

At the end of your chosen Pardner Plan or Susu term, your money will be paid into your designated bank account.

As stated before, please allow 7 days after your term has elapsed, for the money to appear in your account.

It should be sooner, but we do ask you to give us that amount of time to make the payment.
